



New rates in effect October 1, 2002 for Citizens Trash Drop-off Station

The Citizens' Trash Drop-off Station is located at 800 S. East Street. Fees charged to citizens help cover disposal costs for materials brought in, but remain at a discounted rate that is less than what citizens would pay for disposal if they took the material directly to the local landfill.

Currently, the City charges per cubic yard of loose material, including lumber, brush and limbs, and furniture. The rate is \$10 for the first two yards and \$5 per yard over two yards. The costs would be as follows:

Citizens must bring a drivers' license and current water bill as proof of residency. The Trash Drop-off Station is open Tuesdays and Thursdays from 3-5 p.m. and Saturdays from 10 a.m. - 3 p.m. except on holidays.

Free mulch is available to citizens during hours of operation. The mulch is a coarse wood chip mix made from shredding limbs and brush that are brought in to the Station.
